Coppice Primary School Policy for School Sport Premium

School Vision

- To maintain and stimulate increased pupil interest in PE and to promote health and fitness for current and future lifestyles.
- To provide opportunities to allow pupils to broaden their PE experiences both during curriculum and extra curriculum time.
- To identify and develop those pupils who show specific aptitude for individual sports.
- The establishment of pupil self esteem through the development of physical confidence.

The targeted and strategic use of the Primary School Sport Funding will support us in achieving our vision.

Principles

The purpose of this funding is to ensure improvement in the quality of sport and PE provision for all children. (Department for Education, March 2013).

We will ensure that sport and PE provision addresses the needs of all of pupils, including those who belong to disadvantaged, vulnerable and gifted groups.

Primary School Sports funding will be allocated following a whole school needs analysis which will identify priority classes, groups and individuals. In order to address any (identified) areas of need, this funding may be used across particular classes, key stages or whole school at any time during the 2 academic years 2013-14 and 2014-15.

Provision

The range of provision the Governors may consider making could include:-

- Group work with an experienced sports teacher, focussed on overcoming gaps in learning
- Increased pupil participation in sports and extra curricular clubs

- Increased participation in interschool games and competitions at levels 1 and 2
- Detailed assessment of pupil progress in PE
- Develop medium and long term plans for main areas of study for PE
- Additional teaching and learning opportunities provided through professional development courses
- Cover release for professional development
- Quality assured CPD modules/materials
- Specialist Sports teaching
- Qualified Sports coaching
- Sports competitions
- After School sports clubs
- Holiday sports clubs
- Increased swimming provision
- Identify and offer training to junior sports leaders
- Restocking and updating sports equipment

All our work will be aimed at increasing attainment, participation, improving confidence and skills and encouraging a life-long love of sport together with an understanding of the health benefits participation in sports activities offers.

Reporting

It will be the responsibility of the Headteacher, or a delegated member of staff, to produce regular reports for the Governing body on:

- progress made towards improvements, by year group.
- an outline of the provision that was made since the last meeting
- an evaluation of the cost effectiveness, in terms of the progress made by the pupils receiving a particular provision, when compared with other forms of support

The Governors of the school will ensure that there is an annual statement to parents on how the Primary Sport Premium Funding has been used to improve the uptake and outcomes for PE/sports both within and beyond the school day. This task will be carried out within the requirements published by the Department for Education.

Appeal
