A GUIDE TO SCHOOL PARKING

Please do not part on pavements, if necessary to help with the flow of traffic leave enough room for a double buggy or wheelchairs.

Do not part within 10 metres (32 feet) of the junction. Parking here restricts visibility and other road users alike. You may be liable to pay a fixed penalty of £30.

Do not park on double or single yellow lines, only at stated times.

Do not park on zigzag lines; you may be liable to pay a fixed penalty of £30.

Do not block access to a driveway, as well as a £30 fine you could also be liable to having your vehicle removed.

Do not park on a bend.

I appreciate how difficult it can be, especially in poor weather, however responsible car parking will reduce the risk of accidents.
