### Mathematics

During the term, we will continue to develop children's skills by consolidating our knowledge of the numbers to 20 and beginning to look at larger numbers. We will use our numbers in different ways and continue to learn about shapes. This term, we will also find out more about how to doubling numbers, counting in twos and fives, sharing objects fairly and measuring things around us. There will be lots of practical activities for us to do.

### Expressive Arts & Design

In Reception, children are always given opportunities to develop their imagination and creativity through role play, music, dance and making. This term, we will continue to enjoy making models both inside and outside. We might choose to make models of pirate ships or islands as part of our Pirates topic. We will also look at the artist Giuseppe Arcimboldo to help us make our own vegetable art.

### Personal, Social & Emotional

We will be working on developing our relationships with our peers. We will work with partners and as part of a group. We will think about how we can share resources and ideas as well as learn to compromise. If conflict does arise we will work on ways we can solve it.

### Understanding the World

Our topic this term is going to involve us finding out about people from the past and present and how they help us. We will be finding out about the similarities and difference between living things. We will be encouraged to ask lots of questions to find out more. We are very excited about visiting the zoo to find out more about some of the people who help animals.

### Communication & Language

This term is our special assembly. We will all have the chance to get on the stage and say a line for all of the audience to hear. We will ask lots of exciting questions about people from the past and present and about how our body works during Topic lessons. We will also be getting better and better at showing our understanding of stories by answering questions about them when reading.
