


Literacy

We will be:

- Reading a range of text, including poetry, stories and non-fiction
- Learning and reciting a poem
- Planning and writing our own poems
- Researching and writing about rocks, soils and fossils using headings and subheadings
- Identifying the features of leaflets
- Identifying the features of fables, myths and legends



Year 3 Spring Term Themes

Mathematics

- Measuring using a ruler and solving problems including calculating perimeter
- Telling the time on analogue and digital clocks (12 and 24 hour)
- Estimating time to the nearest minute and comparing duration of time
- Continue to recall multiplication and division facts for the 3,4 and 8 times tables
- Solving multiplication and division problems
- Start to use more formal written methods for multiplication and division
- Recognise and use fractions of objects and numbers
- Count up and down in tenths
