Mathematics

Number: Fractions

Compare and order fractions.

Identify, name and write equivalent fractions of a given fraction.

Recognise mixed numbers and improper fractions and convert from one form to the other and write mathematical statements >1 as a mixed number [for example $1\frac{1}{2} = 1\frac{1}{2}$].

Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator and denominators that are multiples of the same number.

Multiply proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers, supported by materials and diagrams.

Read and write decimal numbers as fractions
Solve problems involving multiplication and division, including scaling by simple fractions and problems involving simple rates.

Number: Decimals

Read, write, order and compare numbers with up to three decimal places.

Recognise and use thousandths and relate them to tenths, hundredths and decimal equivalents.
